#### Employment in transport ('000)




- Gross value added by transport, storage, and communication = 4% of GDP (direct)

- Share of female employment = 11% < 13% (Asia), 27% (Europe & North America)



#### Asia-Pacific Road Length (Million km)




#### Road length Total (km) - Maldives







## **VEHICLE OWNERSHIP & PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Between 2010 and 2018, vehicle registrations increased at twice the pace of vessel registrations.









## Share of Rural Population with Access to All-Season Roads, 2022



#### Share of Population Using the Internet




#### **Liner Shipping Connectivity Index**





#### Transport Energy Consumption Share by Mode




#### **Transport Energy Consumption Share by Source**


#### Road share in transport energy consumption





#### **Transport Energy Intensity**










#### Growth of transport – related indicators




#### **Transport share in Fossil CO2 Emissions**









#### Port-specific risk per year as a percentage of the GDP (2021)












## Cumulative number of policy measures




